
Mayor McMillen called the meeting to order and attendance was taken. Alderman Jason Brown made a motion to approve the January minutes and financial statements. Alderman Shawn Couch seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

1. Alderman Aaron Jackson made a motion to deposit money from the sewer fund into a CD at Saint's Avenue Bank for 24 months at a rate of 2.99%, as well as transferring funds from an existing CD as well. Alderman Cristy Browning seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
  2. Unpaid personal property tax statements from 2015-2019 were written off in a motion made by Alderman Shawn Couch and seconded by Alderman Cristy Browning. Motion passed 4-0.
  3. Alderman Shawn Couch made a motion to allow the Park Board to purchase 2 toddler riding toys for the park, to be installed when the merry-go-round is installed. Alderman Jason Brown seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
  4. When there is no water history usage available for a new resident, they will be charged the minimum for the first year, then charged based on their average water usage after that.
  5. The Center Rural Fire Department will cover all costs associated with the brush truck.

Alderman Jason Brown made a motion to approve the bills for payment. Alderman Shawn Couch seconded. Motion passed 3-1. Alderman Jason Brown made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:30 p.m. Alderman Shawn Couch seconded. Motion passed 3-1. The next regular council meeting will be held on March 6, 2019.
